1 Executive Summary

This document is Deliverable **D8.4 First Report on Communication and Dissemination Activities completed in M13-M18** of the EU-funded ResC4EU project. It provides an overview of all communication and dissemination activities performed by the ResC4EU consortium to effectively promote the project and its results in the second year (M13-M18) of the ResC4EU project.

The first half of the second year (M13-M18) of the project focussed on the engagement of SMEs by the ResC4EU Cluster partners through massive communication activities and the dissemination of the first project results (the ResC4EU B2B platform) to build-up interest in the upcoming support for SMEs among their members and beyond

During M13-M18 (Jan-Jun'25), ResC4EU was presented at another **25 events** targeting the **industry, SMEs and citizens** - most of which were organised by the ResC4EU Cluster partners and their networks. In addition, another **4 media articles** were published by the ResC4EU Cluster partners and another **12 news and newsletters** were published on the ResC4EU Cluster partner's websites to reach out to their members and other interested citizens. Through the events about **6,423 people** were reached, with an additional **10,200 people** reached through the media articles and news.

Another **7 events** targeted on **policy engagement**, where the ResC4U project and the ResC4EU B2B platform were promoted by the RecsC4EU Cluster partners towards policy makers including various members of Ministries from Latvia, Poland, Germany, South Korea and Uganda.

A highlight was ISL's presentation on the International Transport Forum (IFT) 2025 Summit, Leipzig, Germany, 21-23 May 2025. Hosted under the OECD, this event is the world's largest gathering of transport ministers and a global policy platform for strategic dialogue on the future of transport, logistics, and mobility.

Outstanding is also the ResC4EU social media presence. Another **13 dedicated LinkedIn news** were created and published by SCA. An effective multiplier effect was created by utilising the project partners own LinkedIn accounts for reposts. By M18, the Resc4EU LinkedIn account had **920 followers**, with 269 gained during the last six months (M13-M18). The ResC4EU website also gained attraction with counting a total of **3,356 visits** by M18.

By M18, ResC4EU was promoted at **a total of 77 events** including 59 events targeting industry, SMEs and citizen, 12 events targeting policy makers and 6 events targeting research communities.

By M18, ResC4EU was promoted by a total of 71 non-scientific publications (e.g. 5 press releases, 30 articles in the press, 10 media articles, 26 website news and newsletters) and so far, no scientific publications. Later are in preparation and will be materialised in the next reporting period.

In summary, the interim **key performance indicators** (see section 10, page 74) have been reached and our communication strategic approach as presented in deliverable **D8.2 Dissemination and Communication Plan** was a great success.

Website analytics

The ResC4EU project website is monitored by Matomo Analytics, which provides insights into its reach and engagement with targeted audiences.

Table 5 summarises the key performance parameters for success (KPIs) of the ResC4EU project website, from its launch on March 7, 2024 (M3), through June 25, 2025 (M18).

By M18, the ResC4EU website recorded **3,356 visits**, including 1,235 new visits during the last six months (M13-M18).

Most visits originated from **Germany (27.4%),** both globally and within Europe, followed by the USA (14.9%), Latvia (6%), Ireland (5.8%), Poland (5.2%), Brazil (5.2%), Austria (4%), and Spain (3.5%) (see **Table** 6 with Matomo Analytics details).





However, the majority of visits (2,346 or 69.9%) were based in Europe.

By M18, the website recorded **6,359 page views**, including 2,232 page views during the last six months (M13-M18).

By M18, the website also recorded **201 downloads**, including 67 downloads during the last six months (M13-M18).

Regarding the channel types, the **majority of visits (65%) came directly** to the website, 14% from search engines, 11% from other websites, and 10% from social networks (LinkedIn).

There was a clear correlation between the major ResC4EU project communication activities and the impact on website visits.

The goal is to build a ResC4EU community with 1000+ followers on LinkedIn, progressively growing by the end of the project and to drive traffic to the ResC4EU website while promoting the project's activities.

In 2024 (M1-M12) and 2025 (M13-M18), the social media presence has been used to share compelling messages to raise awareness of the project, stimulating engagement of the stakeholders, and facilitate rapid communication, such as the presentation of ResC4EU at international fairs and conferences.

LinkedIn Analytics

The ResC4EU LinkedIn account is monitored by LinkedIn Analytics, which provides insights into its reach and engagement with targeted audiences.

Table 7 summarises the key performance indicators (KPIs) of our ResC4EU LinkedIn account from its launch on March 4, 2024 (M3), to June 12, 2025 (M18).

By M18, a total of **31 posts** were created and published by SCA, with 13 posts (no.19 - no.31) created during the last six months (M13-M18).

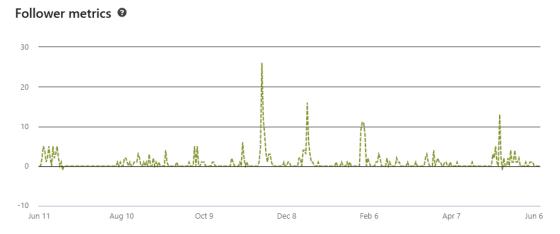


Figure 1: ResC4EU LinkedIn follower metrics and numbers of new followers over time in the last twelve months (M6-M18). Source: LinkedIn Analytics.

During M13-M18, a total of **13** ResC4EU LinkedIn posts (no. 19 – no. 31) were created and published by SCA, with the highest impressions and engagements generated by posts related to the videos 'Project Introduction' and 'SME Support' and the 'Consortium meeting in Athlone, Ireland'.

8 Events – Targeting Industry, SMEs & Citizens in Year 2 (M13- M18)

In the first year of the project, ResC4EU was actively presented on **25 events** targeting industry, SMEs & citizens and a total of **about 6423 people** has been reached directly.

The ResC4EU project was showcased at selected trade fairs, exhibitions, conferences, meetings, seminars, and workshops. More details can be found below.

8.4 On Events - Special events organised by the ResC4EU Clusters including Alliance building

In 2025, ResC4EU has been continuously active in initiating contact with other EU-funded projects, other EU-funded projects and external industrial cluster organisations to explore collaborations and joint communication and dissemination activities. These efforts were led by the ResC4EU Coordinator (TvR, CU) and the ResC4EU Communication and Dissemination Manager (FS, SCA).

Collaborations with Other EU-Funded Projects

Inn 2024, ResC4EU initiated collaborations and joint activities with two cluster-facilitated EU projects aimed at supporting SMEs. These efforts began as early as Month 6 of the project and leveraged existing networks:

- GreenOffshoreTech (H2020) a cluster-facilitated EU INNOSUP project providing cascade funding to SMEs, supporting a total of 83 SMEs.

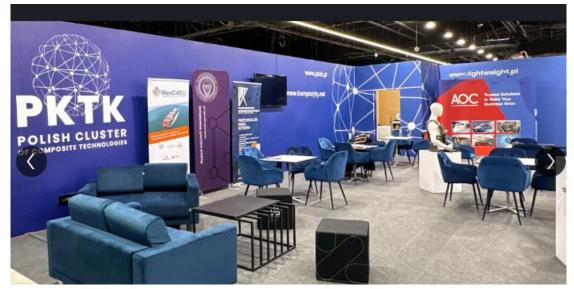

We spent the last two days in #Krakow attending the 5th Conference of the European Lightweighting Network (ELN), which took place at the Łukasiewicz Research Network - Krakow Institute of Technology under the patronage of the Polish EU Council Presidency.

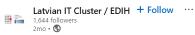
